### DOG POLICY TERMS & CONDITIONS

We welcome dogs at The Bath Priory and there is a small charge of £10.00 per dog for them to stay in your room with you. We regret that the hotel is not able to accept Giant Breeds (eg Great Danes, New Foundlands) or puppies in the rooms (dogs must be ten months or over).

- Dogs must be kept on a lead when in the hotel or on hotel property unless it is in the guest's room.
- If dogs are to be left in the room unattended we request that they are placed in the bathroom behind a child's safety gate.
- Pets are not allowed in any food and beverage area i.e. Library, Drawing room and Dining room, or the Health club and Pool areas of the hotel. This exclusion does not apply to guide dogs.
- Guests are responsible for cleaning up after their dog on hotel property.
- Any disturbances such as barking must be curtailed to ensure other guests are not inconvenienced.
- **Guests must contact the housekeeping department to arrange for a convenient time for servicing their room, turndown service and to be present in the room if room service has been ordered.**
- Guests are responsible for all property damages and/or personal injuries resulting from their dog.
- The hotel reserves the right to charge the guest's account in accordance with the cost of such damages and for deep cleaning as a result of dog litter in the room.
- We will provide you with a card to hang outside your door (stating that there is a dog in the room) and we ask that this remains on your door throughout your stay.
