Bath Priory celebrates retaining its Michelin star

The Bath Priory restaurant in the world heritage city of Bath is delighted to have retained its Michelin star for 2009. The Michelin guide is arguably the most revered restaurant guide amongst chefs, restaurant critics and guests alike and The Bath Priory is honoured to be a part of a group of one star establishments in the UK. The Bath Priory is the only Michelin starred restaurant in Bath.

The Bath Priory was first awarded a star in 1999. Chris Horridge then retained the star for the hotel after joining as Head Chef in June 2005.

As of February 2009, Chris Horridge will be leaving The Bath Priory and the hotel will be celebrating the start of a new era with the appointment of Michael Caines MBE as Executive Head Chef. Michael Caines MBE is one of the UK's highest profile chefs and this year has retained two Michelin stars at the Bath Priory's sister hotel Gidleigh Park, Devon for the tenth consecutive year! (Gidleigh Park is one of only sixteen two Michelin starred restaurants in the UK).

The Bath Priory will be closed for a refurbishment from 2nd February and the hotel will re open on 16th March. The Bath Priory's Spa will be re-opening in the summer months after refurbishment.
