



The Bath Priory wins a Silver Award in the Green Tourism Business Awards



The Bath Priory Hotel and Restaurant is delighted to announce it has won a Silver Award in the Green Tourism Business Awards. The Green Tourism Business Scheme is the national sustainable tourism certification scheme for the UK and is now the only certification scheme validated by Visit Britain, through the International Centre for Responsible Tourism (ICRT).

The hotel was assessed by a qualified grading advisor against a rigorous set of criteria, covering a range of areas, such as energy and water efficiency, waste management and biodiversity amongst others. The assessor commented on the use of the hotel's landscaped gardens, which focus on the importance of using regional produce. The hotel kitchen uses much of the fruit and vegetable produce from the well-stocked Kitchen Garden (tended to by the award-winning Head Gardener Jane Moore) as well as herbs and edible flowers. There are measures in place to reduce the amount of energy consumption, including the use of induction hobs in the hotel's Michelin-starred kitchen. Water efficiency is also practiced throughout the hotel, with implementations to reduce water consumption and pollution.
